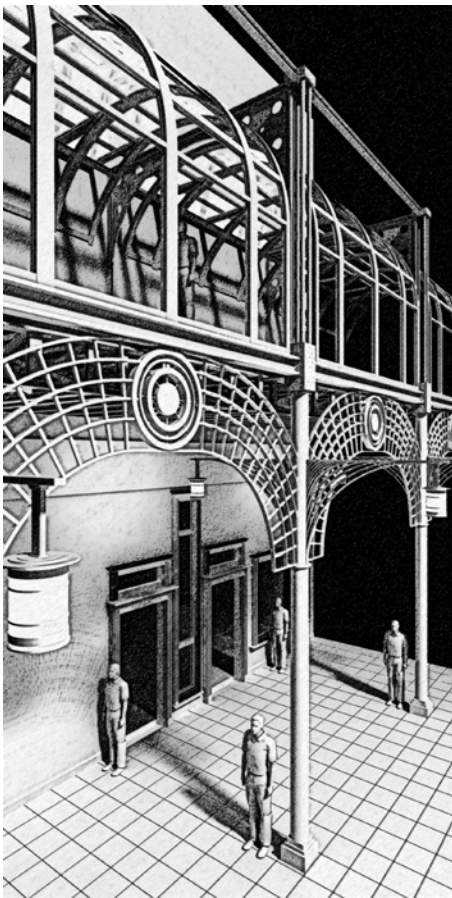

THE SECOND STORY TRAMWAY



Built during the Industrial Revolution, the Second Story Tram serves the Hingeway Borough. With access doors in every building, the Tram can be flagged down much like a bus. Using the Original automated system, each resident has a punch card which lets them signal the Tram. Visitors to the borough can purchase a short term card. THE DREAMING SPIRES THE FINGERS OF ATLAS

“Great silver grey monoliths, ancient arcane pylons who’s latticework structures dominate the skyline of Hingeway Borough.
